- **Call to Order:** President Tiffany called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

- **Approval of the Agenda:** On a motion duly made and seconded, the Board approved the Agenda as presented.
- **Approval of Minutes:** The Board approved the Minutes of the February 2026 Meeting on a motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried.
- **Board Reports**
  - a. **Directors of Cheer:** Director Moreno had no report
  - b. **Dir. of Football Operations:** Director Zepeda reported on the following items:
    - Registration numbers continue to be promising. Looks like we will field 10 teams at a minimum, with additional possible.
    - Our first High Pur-Formance camp was very successful. We have the next camp scheduled for March 20<sup>th</sup>.
  - c. **Secretary:** Secretary Kojzarek addressed the following items:
    - The ILGA has passed a resolution honoring our Pop Warner Academic Scholars. Representative Keicher and Senator Syverson will hold a short reception in May for the kids and parents.
    - We have rolled out the new USA Football Planner App as the replacement for GameChanger. So far there have been no issues.
  - d. **Treasurer:** Treasurer Garbrecht reported on the following items:
    - Taxes filed for the organization.
    - We remain in the black and on budget.
    - We have made our payment securing our spots for the Grid Iron Jamboree
  - e. **Dir. of Events & Fundraising:** Director Rodgers addressed the following items:
    - We have our first Wendy's Dine and Share scheduled for March 25<sup>th</sup>, followed by Double R Dogs on April 8<sup>th</sup> and Panera on April 29<sup>th</sup>.
  - f. **Dir. of Concessions:** Dir. May had no report.
  - g. **Dir. of Spirit Wear:** Dir. Bentley reported on the following items:
    - Currently going through existing spirit wear inventory. Looking to sell at the next High Pur-Formance event.
  - h. **Dir. of Field Maintenance:** Dir. Moreno reported on the following:
    - In continued discussion with the vendor on the purchase of new lights for the field.
  - i. **Dir. of Equipment:** Dir. Cline reported on the following items:
    - Equipment has been certified, cleaned and is being returned. We are looking for coaches to help with the process.
  - j. **Dir. of Health & Safety:** Dir. Jarovsky had no report at this time.
  - k. **Dir. of Certifications:** Dir. Dvorin reported on the following items:
    - All forms have been digitized and will be available for signing online. Will also print some out for the camps in case anyone prefers paper copies.





- **President's Report:** President Tiffany discussed the following items:
  - Attended the Pop Warner meeting. Team counts will need to be in by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - Our jerseys have been approved by Pop Warner so we will begin getting our kids fitted.
  - We are proposing a budget neutral, self-sustained 7 on 7 offseason pilot program to allow our teams to work with Coach Foster to install his offence. Each participating athlete will be charged \$150 for the season to cover league costs and uniforms. Players will be returning players, and therefore covered under our insurance policy at no additional cost.
- **Members to be Heard/Old Business:** President Tiffany opened the floor to visitors in attendance. Members of the audience were given the opportunity to voice their concerns and ask questions of the Board.
- **New Business**
  - a. On a motion made and seconded, the Board unanimously approved the 7 on 7 pilot program.
- **Closed Session**
  - a. On a motion duly made seconded and unanimously carried, the Board adjourned to closed session at 8:02pm for the purposes of discussing hardship scholarships.
