- **Spring Registration Update**
  - Opened up 10 days ago, have 805 registered; had 867 all last year
  - Record registrations; record volunteers
    - 272 volunteers
- **Spring Registration Feedback & Suggestions**
  - Be clearer about the non-volunteer fee
  - Be clearer about multi-kid discount
- **Winter Workouts Overview**
  - First winter workout was at Impact this past weekend (12/13)
    - Did Majors earlier this year to allow for practice ahead of evals
  - Minors will start in January
    - Dates will come out in emails in early 2026
  - Other clinics will be offered for instructional levels
- **Player Evaluations Plan & Timeline**
  - For Majors, AAA, and Minors
    - All registered coaches will receive an email from Andrew with pertinent information (dates, times, age level)
    - Majors and AAA will be evaluated together; will be completed by 1/31
      - Must be evaluated to be drafted to Majors
    - Minors will be completed by 2/7
    - ~30 kids per group
  - Outlining eval process and who provides evaluations
    - Majors Head Coaches and their returning staff will evaluate for Majors and provide ratings for AAA, since those coaches won't be known yet
    - Minors Head Coaches and only one assistant coach will evaluate for Minors
- **Summer Camp Dates and Opportunities**
  - Potential free clinics in the spring with the WCU players
  - WCU/LaRosa baseball camp 7/6-9; 7/27-30 (Monday-Thursday), but would also like to expand to satellite camps that occur at East Side/March
    - East Side kids get first dibs at the East Side ones

- WCU registration usually opens in February
- Potentially have snack bar open and keep revenue for the league
- **Director of Travel Ball Position Review**
  - Reviewing the open positions, three areas that Director position would oversee with regard to Revolution
  - Really looking at two positions:
    - Director of Travel Ball - liaises between Revolution and/or other travel programs and East Side
      - Confirms that Revs has handbook and policy
    - Director of Revolution - has autonomy, but does need to have a succession plan in place first
  - Feedback:
    - Discussion of whether the liaison position is necessary
    - We'll need to think about this eventually, given that 80% of Majors players are also playing travel (between Revs and other travel programs)
    - Impact of travel ball on rec (regarding callups from AAA - there were 12 last year, up from 6 from the year before)
- **General Questions:**
  - Will it be a requirement to draft a 10u for Majors?
    - TBD
    - Feedback: mandatory 10s might not make sense anymore
  - What does that mean for District nominations if you have fewer 10s/11s in Majors?  
Can you only be District-eligible if you're in Majors?
  - What kind of communication do 12u parents get about their options?
