  - Little league international has not released a schedule for Norcal All Stars

- 5. Safety Report Kristina
  - A kid needed stitches.
  - Will send out link for trainings.
    - o Board members, coaches and tee ball/ farm team parent
- 6. Registrar Update- Ryn
  - a. Spring Season Registration
    - i. Kids can get grandfathered in, if they move. Not eligible if you have a "break in service"
    - ii. New this year--For farm and tee ball anyone is able to come from any area. Also applies to siblings
    - iii. Allocation based on Roseville residency
    - iv. Removing the COVID disclaimer form
    - v. Registration will begin November 1st
    - vi. Early bird will be for 2 weeks after opening
  - b. Pricing
    - i. Most of the enrollment is via early enrollment
    - ii. Allocation based on Roseville residency
    - iii. Cost includes: All supplies, lights, uniform etc.
    - iv. \$20 Sibling discount

  - iii. Need to set parameters based on volume of membership
  - iv. Scholarship individually approved by Board
  - v. T-Mobile has a scholarship for \$150
    - 1. Child must be on WIC/ Medi-cal to qualify
- 7. Snack Bar Policy
  - a. 1 revision- Remove Mary add Kaylee
  - b. Accountability on Families
  - c. 18 or older to work the Snack Bar
  - d. No option to "buy out" of volunteer service
- 8. Constitution
  - a. Section 14- Replace "team mom" with "team Parent"
  - b. Motion to have constitution approved—Approved by everyone
- 9. Bylaws
  - a. Article 3 section 1: Appointments
    - i. Add periods or take them away. Be consistent.
    - ii. Last bullet: Interviews for Tee Ball/ Farm are at the discretion of the board.
    - iii. All appointments expire seasonally (not annually)
  - b. Section 2: Qualifications
    - i. all volunteers are subject to little league international and state law requirements.
    - ii. Remove "Note"
    - iii. Revisit an evaluation of each manager
  - c. "Strike out" number requirements for players in 50/70 and Juniors
  - d. Page 12- Added Junor/ 50/70 to reflect same verbiage as minors

- e. Page 20- Section 12
  - i. AAA- Winner of Championship game goes to TOC
  - ii. 50/70 best overall record in regular season goes to TOC
  - iii. Major TOC selection- Remove 1<sup>st</sup> half Vs 2<sup>nd</sup> half method New Proposal: Team A- Winner of regular season. Team B winner of Champion game. If it's the same as winner of regular season, it will be runner up of Championship game. Remove 1<sup>st</sup> half Vs 2<sup>nd</sup> half method
  - iv. Motion to accept the changes to the Bylaws-Approved
