



2026 All-Star Post-Season Commitment Form

Being chosen to a Little League All-Star team is a distinct honor and privilege as well as a responsibility. Although there may be many individuals who desire to play post-season, players selected demonstrate superior ability and skill and also a desire to improve their level of play. To develop a competitive and representative team, parents and players must understand that there are significant time commitments and some financial commitments. For example, these expectations include:

- The ability to attend practices and games until the All-Star season is completed. Practices and games are normally held several days per week, and games may be located outside of College Station, especially if the team advances beyond the District tournament.
- Participation in other activities that would conflict with practices and games should be scheduled for a time after tournament play or to minimize conflict with All-Star activities. A player can be removed from the team at the discretion of the All-Star team manager (with the approval of the CSLL Board of Directors) if the player misses too many practices or games. Examples of conflicting activities include family vacations, summer athletic camps, other sports or activities, etc.
- There could be a small fee for the All-Star uniform. Parents could also be responsible for some expenses associated with travel, especially if the team advances beyond the District tournament. There may also be some optional expenses such as “family” shirts, team support signs, etc.

Practices for the 8-9-10 Year Old All-Stars, 9-10-11 Year Old All-Stars, and 10-11-12 Year Old All-Stars could begin right after the end of the regular season, and games will probably start sometime early June. The exact dates and locations will be set by District 33 personnel and the league presidents. These tournaments are typically double elimination, and the winner of the District 33 tournament will advance beyond district play. The 8-9-10 Year Old All-Stars and 9-10-11 Year Old All-Stars could advance on to the Sectional tournament and State tournament. The 10-11-12 Year Old All-Stars could advance to a Sectional tournament, State tournament, Regional tournament, and the Little League World Series in Williamsport, PA in August.

By signing below, I am indicating that my child and I realize that there is a time and financial commitment beyond the regular season, and permitting for my child to be considered for post-season selection. We understand that, if we fail to participate as expected, it may impact participation level during tournament play.
