



CPLL All-Star Tournament Teams

The All-Star process is intended to be fair, thoughtful, competitive, and aligned with the values of Little League Baseball. While not every eligible player or coach will be selected, CPLL is committed to conducting the process with integrity, confidentiality, and respect for all participants and families.

The mission of the CPLL All-Star Program is to build competitive teams that reflect the values of:

- **Teamwork**
- **Community**
- **Inclusion**
- **Integrity**
- **Fun**

We strive to compete at a high level and we believe how we play the game matters just as much as the outcome. Our All-Star teams should represent our league with pride, sportsmanship, and respect.

Player Selection Criteria

Players may be considered for All-Star selection based on:

- Baseball ability and game knowledge
- Sportsmanship and attitude
- Coachability and work ethic

- Team-first mindset
- Positional needs of the team
- Respect for teammates, coaches, opponents, umpires, and families
- Compliance with league and Little League rules
- Availability and commitment to attend all practices and tournament games

GameChanger stats are not considered.

Commitment Matters

All-Star participation requires a significant commitment from both the player and their family. Players selected are expected to fully participate in:

- Practices
- Tournament games
- Team activities, if applicable

Availability is an important part of the selection process. Only players who complete the CPLL All Star Verification of Availability Form and commit to attend all practices, games and team activities (if applicable) for the duration of the post-season are eligible to be placed on the All Star ballots.

Selection Process

The All-Star player selection process is overseen by:

- League President
- Vice President
- Player Agent
- Secretary
- Division Managers

Teams are selected in the following age groups based on Little League age:

8/9's, 10's, 11's, 12's, Juniors

Each All-Star team consists of **12 players**.

The selection process includes:

- **Complete and submit the CPLL All Star Verification of Availability Form. Only players fully committed to the entire post-season run are eligible to have their names placed on the All-Star ballots.**
- **Player voting**

- **Manager ranking**
- **Manager discussion and final roster selection**
- **Approval of each roster by the CPLL Executive Board**

Voting

Players vote by confidential ballot for eligible players in the division which they play.

- Players vote for up to **8 players** in each age group of their division.

Ranking

Managers rank all eligible players in the appropriate All-Star age group(s) in the division which they manage.

Final Roster Selection

The top five vote recipients automatically earn spots on the roster to be sent for Executive Board approval. The remaining seven roster spots are determined during a **confidential manager All-Star selection meeting** based on:

- Player performance
- Team balance
- Positional needs
- Leadership, Attitude, Sportsmanship
- Overall team fit

All player selections are subject to final approval by the **CPLL Executive Board**.

Confidentiality

To protect the fairness and integrity of the process:

- Voting results remain confidential
 - Manager and Executive Board selection discussions remain confidential

Official Team Announcement

Selected All-Star teams are to be announced only by the:

- **League President**, and/or

- **Player Agent**

Announcement by CPLL shall only occur on or after the date permitted by **Little League and District 12 rules**.

Reminder: Managers shall not disclose selections prior to CPLL's announcement.

Player Expectations

Selection to an All-Star team is both an honor and a responsibility.

Selected players are expected to demonstrate:

- Sportsmanship, including respect for teammates, coaches, opponents, umpires, and families
 - Commitment to attendance and participation
 - Compliance with league and Little League rules

Required Player Documentation

If selected, players/families are required to submit tournament documents by the stated deadline, including:

- Tournament Player Verification Form
- Original Birth Certificate
- Proof of Residency or School Enrollment documentation
- Medical Release Form

Failure to submit required documentation in a timely manner may affect eligibility.

Manager & Coach Selection

All-Star managers and coaches are selected after player rosters are finalized.

Managers and coaches are considered based on:

- Commitment to Little League values
- Support of Cambrian Park Little League
- Sportsmanship and professionalism

- Coaching ability and leadership
- Regular season coaching eligibility under Little League rules

The President will gather a list of managers and coaches interested in serving on an All-Star team. Interested candidates will complete and submit a **Google Form** (or similar application) to the President.

The President will determine one manager and two coaches for each tournament team and submit for approval to the **CPLL Executive Board**.

The All-Star process often involves difficult decisions among many deserving players and coaches.

Being selected is an honor, and **not being selected is not a reflection of a player's value, character, or future potential**. Team selection is based on a combination of factors, including positional needs and team balance at a specific time.
