POOL PLAYERS

THERE ARE NO POOL PLAYERS FOR FALL

MERCY/FORFEIT

No 15, 10, or 8 Run Rule/ No Forfeits/ If a team is short players, borrow players from the other team and play them in the outfield.

5-3 RULE (AA - MAJOR DIVISION)

At-bat ends when 5 runs or 3 outs are recorded; whichever comes first; Teeball bats full roster to end at-bat

INFIELD FLY RULE (AAA AND MAJOR DIVISION)

A fair fly ball which, in the opinion of the umpire, can be caught with ordinary effort, when 1st and 2nd base, or 1st, 2nd, and 3rd base are occupied with less than 2 outs. Does not include line drives or bunt attempts.

UNCAUGHT THIRD STRIKE (MAJOR DIVISION ONLY)

Batter is out if 1st base is occupied with less than 2 outs. If 1st base is unoccupied, or there are 2 outs, the batter becomes a runner and must be put out

MANDATORY PLAY (OFFENSE; A - MAJOR DIVISION)

Continuous Batting Order(CBO)

MANDATORY PLAY (DEFENSE; A - MAJOR DIVISION)

No players sit a second time until ALL players sit one time

SPECIAL RUNNERS (AA - MAJOR DIVISION)

With two outs, a courtesy runner may be used for pitcher or catcher of record using the player who made the last out. If both pitcher and catcher are run for, the players making the last 2 outs are used, in order starting from closest to home.

MAXIMUM PITCH COUNT (AA - MAJOR DIVISION)

Pitchers are limited to throwing 2 consecutive innings or 50 pitches utilizing thresholds(whichever comes first).
Threshold pitch count - pitch count reverts back to the first pitch thrown to the last batter.
Managers are responsible for keeping pitch count for their team's pitchers

MOUND VISITS (AA - MAJOR DIVISION)

(AA AND AAA) Pitcher must be removed from the mound on the third visit in an inning or fourth visit in the game.
(MAJOR) Pitcher must be removed from the mound on the second visit in an inning or third visit in the game.

PITCHER>CATCHER OR CATCHER>PITCHER

A player that throws 41 or more pitches in a game is not eligible to catch the remainder of that day
A player that catches in four or more innings in a game is not eligible to pitch the remainder of that day
A player that catches in 3 or less innings AND throws 21+ pitches is not eligible to catch again that day

PITCHING DISTANCE (AA ONLY)

40' for the first five games using the portable pitching mound
46' for the last five games beginning October 11.

FIELD RESPONSIBILITIES

Visiting Team - Pre-game Field Prep Home Team - Post-game field clean up Inter-league games NLL team does both

END OF GAME CONDUCT

All players, managers and coaches are required to shake hands, high five or fist bump with every player, manager and coach of the opposing team in a show of good sportsmanship.
