All-Star Selection Policy

Adopted:

April 15, 2026

Purpose

To establish a fair, transparent, and competitive process for selecting South Garland Little League All-Star teams.

Eligibility

- Players must be registered and in good standing with SGLL
- Players must meet all eligibility requirements set by Little League International
- Required documentation must be submitted prior to participation in tryouts

Tryout Process

- All eligible players are allowed to participate in open tryouts
- Tryouts will be conducted on a scheduled date determined by the league
- Players will be evaluated on performance, effort, attitude, and baseball IQ

Selection Process

- All-Star Coaches will be selected by the Executive Board prior to tryouts
- Selected coaches will attend and evaluate players during tryouts
- Player selection will be made by the All-Star coaching staff
- Selections will be based on overall evaluation of player ability, team fit, and competitiveness

President Oversight:

- The League President retains final review authority over all roster selections
- The President may exercise veto power if eligibility rules, policies, or process were not followed
- Any veto action should be communicated with reasoning
- Final rosters are subject to Executive Board approval

Team Formation

- Teams will be formed by division
- Final rosters approved by Executive Board
- Team size aligned with Little League guidelines

Timeline

- Coach Selection: 5/1
- Tryouts: 5/17
- Player Selection: 5/17
- Team Announcement: 5/20
- Practices Begin: 5/20

Uniforms & Costs

- SGLL will provide hat, jersey, belt, and socks
- Players provide their own pants
- Travel costs are family responsibility
- Families should consider travel commitments before accepting

Conduct & Expectations

- Players and families must represent SGLL with sportsmanship
- Failure to meet expectations may result in removal

Authority & Amendments

- Adopted by SGLL Executive Board
- Board retains authority to update
- Major changes require board vote
