



2026 WFBLL Call Ups and Sub Rules

Note: If there is an instance where a rule isn't specified in this document, WFBLL will use official Little League rules. If there is a disagreement regarding rules during a game, the umpires and/or Board Member on Duty (BMOD) have final decision rights.

General Rules:

1. The purpose of call ups/subs are:
 - a. To ensure all games can be played as scheduled.
 - b. To allow players more opportunities to play baseball/softball.
2. The goal of the call ups/subs process are:
 - a. To promote equity and fair opportunity to all players who are eligible for and wish to participate as a call up/sub.
3. When a team will have fewer than 9 players for a game, they should request Call Up players from the division below; Minors should request Pee Wees Call Ups and Majors should request Minors Call Ups.
4. Games should not be rescheduled because not enough existing team members can be present for the game.
5. Coaches should not contact players, parents, or other coaches directly to request Call Ups. All requests for Call Ups need to be coordinated through the appropriate division Commissioners.
6. Call Ups/Subs must hit at the bottom of the batting order.
7. A team cannot use more Call Up players than it takes for the roster to get to nine players. If a team has Call Ups to start a game and then regular roster players arrive after the game has started, those Call Ups shall continue to play the rest of the game even if the roster for that game is now more than nine players. The arriving players must hit at the end of the order.

Pee Wees Baseball Rules:

1. Pee Wee players can EITHER serve as a sub for other Pee Wees teams OR serve as a Call Up to Minors games. The purpose of this either/or approach is to allow more kids the opportunity to play more baseball.
2. For the purpose of safety of the players, ONLY the Pee Wee teams' Coach will determine which players are eligible to serve as Minors Call Ups. Each Coach should confirm with the eligible players/parents if they wish to serve as a Minors Call Up OR serve as a Pee Wees sub.
3. If Pee Wees teams need a substitution player, the Coach should ask the other Pee Wee baseball coaches if they have an available player who is NOT on the Minors call up list. Pee Wees Softball Rules:

1. Pee Wee softball players can serve as a sub for other Pee Wee softball teams.
2. If a Pee Wee softball team needs a substitution player, the Coach should ask the other Pee Wee softball coaches if they have an available player.

Minors Rules:

1. Requests for Pee Wees Call Ups should be made by texting BOTH the Pee Wees Commissioner, George Eliopoulous (414.265.8102 or peeweess@wfbll.com) **and** Minors Commissioner, Megan Hoefler (907.830.9836 or minors@wfbll.com). Minors coaches should not contact players, parents, or other coaches directly. Players will be assigned to Minors teams in a fair and equitable fashion.
2. Minors players can serve as substitution players for Majors games only.

Majors Rules:

1. Requests for Minors Call Ups should be made by texting BOTH the Minors Commissioner, Megan Hoefler (907.830.9836 or minors@wfb.com) **and** Majors Commissioner, Andrew Liska (262.844.9806 or majors@wfbll.com). Majors coaches should not contact players, parents, or other coaches directly. Players will be assigned to Majors teams in a fair and equitable fashion.
