Code of Conduct

- Accept all official decisions as final—no arguing or confrontations.
- Show respect at all times and refrain from shouting at coaches, athletes, officials, or staff.

2. Positive Sportsmanship

- Set a good example by demonstrating good sportsmanship.
- Promote a culture of respect and inclusivity for all facility participants.

3. Safety and Facility Rules

- Follow all facility rules and staff instructions.
- No drugs on the premises.

4. Consequences for Violations

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in:

- A verbal warning from facility staff.
- Removal from the facility for the remainder of the event.
- Suspension or permanent ban from attending future events.
