Treasurer report:- 1,191.41, 7,219, 885.99, 13,162, 7,979 and 8,071 in accounts. Cosmic tickets. We bought 100. 22 left. Set to make 2000 in funds when all are sold. Water bill due about 5,000. Grandslam is the next big bill after the water bill. Cost of TWLL at Grandslam approximately 7,000 for the year. They do not have the availability for us to do clinics at grandslam. We are looking into Coyle for coaching clinics, it would be around 100 for each use. Christian asked to have them keep it the same price. There is no contract with Babe Ruth for the use of the facility. They are going to discuss it with the board and see if they will keep the cost the same for us. Chris Coute is going to look into different gyms. Steve F, said a gym would work.

Player agent report: Answering some emails from parents about players not making Majors teams. If we have enough kids next year there may be another Majors team. If that happens there will have to be a league draft.
