## XXXVIII. MAJORS, JUNIOR, AND SENIOR RULES

- A. There shall be no time limit for Majors, Junior and Senior division games but shall be held to the night game time limitations delineated in Section XXV.E, entitled "Game Start/End Times and Night Game End Times". As the visiting team at another complex, teams shall abide by the respective league's game time restrictions.
- B. Metal cleats may be worn for Junior and Senior only.
- C. For the Junior and Senior division, players may be used as 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> base coaches but must wear their batting helmet. Players may not be used as 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> base coaches in the Majors division.
- D. Game scores shall be recorded and a scorebook utilized to document the games.
- E. Umpires' calls shall be final and there is a "ZERO" tolerance policy for arguing with an umpire, particularly balls and strikes. This includes constant chirping, from the dugout, or asking the umpire where the pitch was.
- F. For the Junior and Senior divisions, there shall be an on deck circle.
- G. No on deck circle shall be used for the Majors division. Players must always be confined to dugout enclosure. At no time are they allowed to swing while on deck either within the field of play or outside the field of play. At no time are they

allowed to swing, while on deck, either within the field of play or outside the field of play. If a player violates this rule, the manager and coaches will get one warning. If it happens again, then the manager will be suspended for one game.

This rule is in place to protect our players.

- H. The playing rules for these divisions shall be only those delineated in the Little League Rulebook.
