XXXV. TEE BALL DIVISION RULES

- A. Games shall be no more than 1 hour in duration, no more than 3 innings, and there is no minimum number of players required to be present.
- B. No inning shall start after 45 minutes.
- C. Half innings shall end when all batters have batted
- D. There shall be a continuous batting order used.
- E. In spring season, for the first three weeks, the batting tee will be used by all players. After the first three weeks, players will receive coach pitch, four pitches only, if the play does not hit after **four pitches**, the batting tee **MUST** be used.
- F. There are no strikeouts. In fall season, coaches have the option to start immediately with coach pitch if the player is capable.
- G. When a ball is batted within the infield, the runner shall only advance to first base.
- H. Runners shall not advance on errors.
- I. A batter may advance to 2nd base on a batted ball that reaches the outfield grass on a fly only.
- J. If an out is made by a fielder, the batter/runner shall return to the bench.
- K. All players shall play in the field.
- L. Each team shall field the following positions:
 - 1. One pitcher
 - 2. One first baseman
 - 3. One 2nd baseman
 - 4. One 3rd baseman

5. One short stop
 6. One catcher, which is an optional position, but if filled they must wear all protective catching gear.
 7. All remaining players shall be distributed in the outfield.
- M. No player shall play two consecutive innings in the outfield.
- N. Fielders shall be encouraged to throw the ball to the appropriate base to record outs.
- O. Prevent players from fielding the ball and racing to a base, risk injuring themselves or others.
- P. Coaches are permitted in the field of play with their team.
- Q. If the Tee Ball field is not playable, the games shall be played in the VCC, if available, and with prior approval from the Tee Ball Coordinator, Vice President of Baseball Operations, and the VCC Manager.
