  - a. Kemp, Krohn, Ainsworth visited the Barn
  - b. Holiday Inn more restrictive
    - i. Will cater all food and complete all clean up
    - ii. No additional fundraising option through sale of alcohol
    - iii. \$500 for venue
    - iv. \$5000 total cost
  - c. The Barn
    - i. \$250 for venue
    - ii. Can sell alcohol for more fundraising
    - iii. Barn takes \$1 per beer
    - iv. We would have to clean up
      - v. \$3000 all in including chili from golf course
    - vi. Plenty of room including outside area for kids to play
    - vii. Could have boys complete clean up/take out trash
    - viii. Auction area is available upon entrance to the facility
      - ix. Max 525 occupancy but not very strict
