- 1. Approve Minutes from 4.09.25 BOD Meeting
 - a. Sarvis motion to approve, Kozel 2nd, minutes approved
- Treasurer's Report (Jessi)
 - a. Youth
 - i. \$50,334 in the bank
 - ii. Crow Peak Tournament generated \$7,000
 - iii. Concessions \$3390
 - iv. Net profit was \$8700 for the Youth
 - v. Umpire fees have been biggest expense since last meeting (mainly from the tournament).
 - b. Senior
 - i. \$28,214.02 in the bank
 - ii. Kids that umpired donated fees of \$875
 - iii. Jessi & Parker met to go over budget. Worst case scenario is \$25,700 short prior to additional fund raising opportunities.
 - iv. Per Schultz, the Legion will reimburse registration fees
 - v. Steve is meeting with Booster Club about the Optimist football playoff fundraiser. Usually generates about \$10,000. Tara with Booster Club will likely agree to take that on.
 - vi. Dave Donat went to Lions Club and they will donate a set of catcher's equipment.
- 3. Coaches Report (Parker) (Krohn for Parker)
 - a. Not a ton to report in-season
 - b. Jackson Hatten wants to play Legion but hasn't paid
 - c. Krohn recommended he practice but no games until he pays
 - d. Possibly another player moving to Spearfish at some point this summer
 - e. Parker's credit card was snapped in half. He will call bank to have one reissued

- 4. Youth Director Report (Gary)
 - a. Looking for feedback on tournament
 - b. Maxed out on the amount of teams using the Sawmill Complex
 - i. If we want to grow, we would have to expand to other locations like Sky Ridge or BHSU fields.
 - c. There was an issue on the 9U field that was being umpired by 2 of our 14U players and they ejected a fan from Mandan. Discussion as to how to have a tournament director present at each field.
 - i. A pre-tournament meeting with the umpires would be beneficial.
 - d. Rec baseball is in-season. Seems to be growing at the younger levels.
 - e. Gary would like to retain Dean Hansen in some way. Whether that's as a coach for 14U and/or weight training for 7th and 8th graders to fill a need that the high school can't fill.
