

# HVABSA Music Policy

## Purpose

The Highland Village Area Baseball/Softball Association (HVABSA) is committed to providing a safe, positive, and family-friendly environment at all games and events. This policy establishes clear expectations for the use of music to ensure it enhances the game-day atmosphere while respecting players, families, and the integrity of the game.

## Policy Guidelines

<b>Respect the Game – Keep It Family Friendly</b>	Music should always contribute to a positive and enjoyable experience for players, coaches, and spectators.
<b>Volume Control</b>	Music must be kept at a respectful volume and should not interfere with game play, umpire communication, or the enjoyment of fans.
<b>Content Restrictions</b>	No profanity, offensive language, or inappropriate content in lyrics or speech is permitted at any time.
<b>Timing of Music</b>	All music must stop once the batter enters the batter's box. Music may resume only during approved breaks in play (e.g., between innings, pitching changes, or pregame warmups).
<b>Enforcement</b>	If a violation occurs, a warning will be issued. Continued violations will result in the immediate revocation of music privileges for the remainder of the game.
