HVABSA Music Policy

Purpose

The Highland Village Area Baseball/Softball Association (HVABSA) is committed to providing a safe, positive, and family-friendly environment at all games and events. This policy establishes clear expectations for the use of music to ensure it enhances the game-day atmosphere while respecting players, families, and the integrity of the game.

Policy Guidelines

Respect the Game – Keep It Family Friendly	Music should always contribute to a positive and enjoyable experience for players, coaches, and spectators.
Volume Control	Music must be kept at a respectful volume and should not interfere with game play, umpire communication, or the enjoyment of fans.
Content Restrictions	No profanity, offensive language, or inappropriate content in lyrics or speech is permitted at any time.
Timing of Music	All music must stop once the batter enters the batter's box. Music may resume only during approved breaks in play (e.g., between innings, pitching changes, or pregame warmups).
Enforcement	If a violation occurs, a warning will be issued. Continued violations will result in the immediate revocation of music privileges for the remainder of the game.
