

Tee Ball League Summary – Division Rules

Game Structure

- **2 innings** or **50-minute maximum** (no new inning may start after 50 minutes).
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Batting Format

- **No outs per inning** – instead, **each team bats through their full lineup** every inning.
 - All players get equal at-bats, regardless of defensive plays made.
 - Batting order stays consistent throughout the game.
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Batting Rules

- Each batter gets:
 1. **2 coach tosses** → If no hit...
 2. **3 swings off the tee**
 - If still no hit, **coach may assist once**.
 - **Foul ball** on the 3rd strike = **extra swing**.
 - The ball must travel at least **5 feet** (marked line) to be considered fair.
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Base Running Limitation

- Batter is awarded **first base only**, regardless of hit distance or defensive error.
 - No advancing on overthrows.
 - Runners advance **one base per batter**.
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Fielding

- All players play defense.
- **Infield:** 5 players maximum.
- **Outfield:** All remaining players, positioned behind baselines.
- **No catcher** position in tee ball.
- No same position two innings in a row.
- Pitcher must stay **25 feet from the batter** (line marked).

Defense & Umpiring

- Coaches from the **defensive team** make calls.
- Pitcher can only **cover home plate**.
- All other players must **throw to a base** unless positioned on it.

Scorekeeping

- **No official scorekeeping.**
- Emphasis is on **development, teamwork, and enjoyment**
