FORMAT

The top two teams from each district qualify for the 2025 NC State Little League 7-8 Machine Pitch Tournament. District 6 will have the option of bringing in a 3rd place team if needed to fill out an even number of teams. Each team will play three randomly drawn pool play games. The top 4 teams and any team with a 2-1 record or better will automatically qualify for the single-elimination finals. Pool play games will start at 10:00 am on Saturday, July 5. The tournament is scheduled to end on July 8.

Directions to J. Burt Gillette Baseball Complex From Fayetteville

Take I-95 N toward Rocky Mount Take the US-264 ALT exit 121 toward WILSON Turn RIGHT onto US-264 ALT E toward WILSON Keep STRAIGHT and road becomes RALEIGH RD NW At the intersection of RALEIGH RD NW & WARD BLVD take a LEFT

Go Approx. 3 Miles & turn left on to CORBETT AVE

Go Approx. 0.3 Miles and look on your right J. Burt Gillette Athletic Complex will be on your right, Turn Right into the Complex Go to the left towards the All Children's Playground and stay straight the baseball complex will be straight ahead.

From Wilmington

Merge onto I-40 W toward BENSON / RALEIGH Merge onto I-95 N via EXIT 328 B toward ROCKY MOUNT / SMITHFIELD Take the US-264 ALT exit 121 toward WILSON Turn RIGHT onto US-264 ALT E toward WILSON

Keep STRAIGHT and road becomes RALEIGH RD NW

At the intersection of RALEIGH RD NW & WARD BLVD take a LEFT

Go Approx. 3 Miles & turn left on to CORBETT AVE

Go Approx. 0.3 Miles and look on your right J. Burt Gillette Athletic Complex will be on your right, Turn Right into the Complex

Go to the left towards the All Children's Playground and stay straight the baseball complex will be straight ahead.

From Raleigh

Take I-440 E / US-64 E via EXIT 301 toward ROCKY MOUNT

Merge onto US-264 E / US-64 E via EXIT 14 toward WILSON / ROCKY MOUNT.

Merge onto US-264 E WILSON / GREENVILLE.

Take the US-264-ALT exit- EXIT 36B.

Merge onto US-264 ALT E.

Go 6 miles & at the intersection of RALEIGH RD NW & WARD BLVD take a LEFT

Go Approx. 3 Miles & turn left on to CORBETT AVE

Go Approx. 0.3 Miles and look on your right J. Burt Gillette Athletic Complex will be on your right, Turn Right into the Complex

Go to the left towards the All Children's Playground and stay straight the baseball complex will be straight ahead.
