CAMDEN CHRISTIAN YOUTH ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents will abide by the code of conduct, which includes the following:

- Do not criticize the Conference, Association, Executive Board members, coaches, players and/or cheerleading in public, but reserve constructive criticism for later, in private, with those it involves.
- Accept decisions of the game officials on the field as being fair, and called to the best ability, of said officials.
- Do not criticize an opposing team, its players, coaches, or fans by word of mouth or gestures.
- Emphasize with your child that good athletes strive to be good students and that both are physically and mentally alert.
- Strive to make every football/cheerleader activity serve as a training ground for life, and a basis for good mental and physical health by being there to support your child.
- Emphasize that winning a game is the result of good "TEAMWORK".
- Refrain from talking to your child during games and practices. Any fan who becomes a nuisance and out of control may be asked to leave.
- Refrain from using abusive and profane language before anyone.
- Do not deliberately incite unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Abstain from drinking of alcoholic beverages / using illegal substances at both the game and practice fields.
- Will support all fund raising and other Association activities.
- Will be responsible for completing and turning in all required paperwork during the season on time.
- Will be required to help where needed during Association functions.
- Will not do anything that will be detrimental to the team and/or Association.
- Will be responsible for drop-off and picking up of your child on time to all Association functions.
- Will be responsible for all my child's equipment and uniforms. Will replace anything that is lost, damaged due to misuse, or not turned in at the end of the season.
- Will uphold all Rules, Regulations, Code of Conduct, By-laws, and Board of directives of Camden Christian Youth Athletic Association.
