# Oswego East High School Athletic Booster Club Scholarship Program

The Oswego East High School Athletic Booster Club will be providing up to six (6) \$1,000 athletic scholarships to athletes this school year (2022-2023).

These scholarships are one-time grants, designated to assist student athletes pursuing further education. The scholarships are intended to recognize outstanding graduating athletes of Oswego East High School. Applicants will be evaluated based on their athletic success, dedication, sportsmanship, and leadership, as well as academic achievement and character. To be considered for a scholarship, student athletes must meet the following criteria: ☐ Athletic Participation – Applicant must be a 12<sup>th</sup> grade student in good standing at Oswego East High School who has participated on at least one varsity athletic team during the student's last two years of attending OEHS. ☐ **Booster Club Membership** – The student's parent/guardian must be a current member of the Oswego East High School Athletic Booster Club. Parental membership as of March 15<sup>th</sup> of the academic application year is a prerequisite to the student receiving a scholarship. □ **Academic Achievement** – The student athlete must have a minimum cumulative unweighted high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. ☐ Code of Conduct – Applicant must have complied with School District 308's "Code of Conduct: Athletics and Extracurricular Activities" throughout the Applicants tenure at Oswego East High School. □ **Post-Secondary Education** – The applicant must be accepted by a post-secondary institution. Post-secondary institutions include, but are not limited to, colleges, universities, and technical and vocational schools. ☐ **Letter of Recommendation** - Applicants must have at least one letter of recommendation from a coach, teacher, counselor or administrator at OEHS. Those completing the letter of recommendation must place the letter in a sealed envelope and sign the envelope prior to giving the letter(s) to the applicant. □ **Application Form** – Students must complete and submit, by the posted deadline, the application with all prescribed forms and the <u>sealed</u> recommendation letter(s).

□ Essay – All applicants will write a 2-page essay reflecting on the following topic:

future? All essays must be typed with applicant's name appearing on the first page. The essays will be judged on content, grammar, and organizational style. Applicants will not be considered for selection without the written essay. ☐ Selection Criteria – Scholarships are given based on merit. Financial need is not a factor or consideration in applying for this scholarship. Applicants will be evaluated based on their athletic success, dedication, sportsmanship, and leadership, as well as academic achievement and character. A personal interview may be required as part of the selection process. The student's participation intent in sports at the post-secondary institution will not be a factor in the selection process. ☐ **Selection Committee** – The selection committee will be representatives of the community and school. No identifying information will be given to the selection committee. Parents of the applicant(s) may not serve on the selection committee. □ **Submission** – The completed application form, two sealed recommendations, along with typed essay must be mailed or dropped off at: Oswego East High School Athletic Booster Club Scholarship Committee, Career Center, Oswego East High School, 1525 Harvey Rd.
