

HHYFC OTHER INFORMATION and POLICIES

I understand that it is the HHYFC policy that at various times throughout the season, photographs of players, cheerleaders and Drill Team involved in HHYFC events may be taken by club or by organizations authorized by the club for promotional purposes to be used in print or on the website.

Furthermore, I hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless the HHYFC, its Board Members, agents, and assignees from any liability, claims, demands and judgments arising out of injury or loss sustained by the participant or any person related to the participant in connection with the HHYFC activities and facilities.

REFUND POLICY

REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. NO EXCEPTIONS.

ASSIGNMENT OF PARTICIPANT TO TEAMS

The Trustees supervise the player draft. Teams are divided into multiple colors including Red, White and Black. All siblings are assigned to the same color/team based on the oldest sibling in the program. Requests to play on a specific team or to be on a team with a friend are not permitted. Head Coaches draft their team. If you do not wish to be placed back on the same color, you need to write a letter to the HHYFC Board of Trustees stating the reason why. The Trustee's will review these on a case by case basis.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

HHYFC requires all participants to have a physical check up. Physicals must be in the 2018 calendar year. Physicals dated prior to 1/1/2018 will NOT be accepted by the Gem City Youth Conference (GCYC). **** ONLY THE HHYFC APPROVED PHYSICAL FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

EQUIPMENT POLICY

I acknowledge that I am responsible for returning all HHYFC issued equipment at the end of the season in acceptable condition. I agree to pay the replacement cost for any equipment issued to my child lost or damaged beyond normal wear. If the borrowed equipment is not returned, my child will not be permitted to register for the next season until the equipment has been returned. **In Addition, I understand that I will be billed the current cost to purchase a replacement set. I also understand that my child will not receive a participation trophy until all equipment is turned in.**

CONCERNS AND GRIEVANCES

All concerns and grievances against any coach, player, board member, official or Spectator must be submitted in writing to the HHYFC Board of Directors. All grievances or concerns against coaches must be submitted in writing and addressed to Director of Coaches or any HHYFC Board Member. Only written and signed concerns and grievances will be reviewed.
