Fingerprint Background Check (Mandatory *before* Coaching)

STEP 1: Complete the attached **New Jersey Universal Fingerprint Form** for Youth Serving Organization Volunteer. **The form should have pre-printed info:** ORI #: NJ920610Z, Category: YSB, Statute: 15A:3A-1, Reason: Youth Serving Organization Volunteer, Doc Type: VB1. **YOU MUST FILL IN:** Contributor's Case # (Box 7): P15004 [the "0s" are zeroes]

STEP 2: Complete the remainder of the IdentoGo application and schedule an appointment at Morpho Trak on-line (no walk-ins) at www.bioapplicant.com/nj. You may need information from the Universal Fingerprint Form above and scheduling may take several weeks. The **Cost is \$28.66**, which the volunteer must pay at the time of background check.

STEP 3: After fingerprinting is complete, submit Morpho Trak receipt to your Sports Association or Organization for reimbursement. A copy of the receipt must also be submitted to Mount Olive Twp. Recreation/Administration along with an address, email, sport and phone number on it so you can be notified of the background check result.

The Police Dept. will receive a letter from the Volunteer Review Organization advising of the volunteer's eligibility under the law. Mount Olive Township Recreation will be notified of the results of the background check and will contact the volunteer.

Appeals- Appeals must be filed in writing to the Chief of Police within 30 days after notification from the Township that the background check revealed information which would serve to disqualify a person.

Persons who have been denied based on a recommendation by the VRO must obtain a copy of their criminal history record by completing the Criminal History Record Release Form and mailing it to the New Jersey State Police. You must email the Mount Olive Police Dept. Communications Division at VRO@mopd.org to obtain the form. Once you receive a copy of your criminal history, you are to contact the Mount Olive Township Police Communications Division at VRO@mopd.org to start the appeal process.

Identification Requirement - Acceptable identification must be presented at the <u>time of printing</u> . Identification presented MUST be one (1) document that is current (not expired). A combination of documents will not be accepted. The single document must include the following criteria: Photo, Name, Address (home/issuing agency), Date of Birth. Acceptable ID must be issued by a Federal, State, County or Municipal entity for identification purposes. Examples of acceptable ID are: 1) Valid U.S. State Photo Driver's License/ Non Driver's License, 2) U.S. Passport, 3) USCIS Permanent Resident ID Card (issued after 5/10/2010), and 4) USCIS Employment Authorization Card (issued after 10/31/2011).					

Please READ This Form Carefully:

Follow all of the instructions provided by your agency/employer to complete the fingerprint process. You must have this form (Blocks 1 through 26) completed prior to scheduling your fingerprint appointment via the website or call center. **PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY.** It is **required** that you **present** this completed Universal Fingerprint Form, IDG_NJAPP_051719_V1, at your scheduled appointment.

Appointment Scheduling:

Scheduling is available anytime at www.bioapplicant.com/nj. Appointments may also be scheduled through our Call Center. English and Spanish speaking agents are available at 1-877-503-5981, Monday through Friday, 8:00AM to 5:00PM EST and Saturday, 8:00AM to 12 Noon EST.

Payment:

When an applicant is responsible for payment, payment is required at the time of scheduling. The following forms of payment are accepted: Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover and prepaid debit cards, or electronic debit (ACH) from a checking account. Accounts will be debited immediately.

Cancel/ Reschedule:

Appointments may be canceled or rescheduled via the website or the call center **before the deadline of 5PM EST** the business day prior to the scheduled appointment (Saturday Noon for Monday appointments). An appointment fee of \$12.00 plus tax (\$12.80) will be incurred by applicants who do not cancel/reschedule their appointment prior to the deadline. Idemia Identity & Security will refund the remainder of the fee paid (state/federal search fees) to the original payment method.

Unable to be Fingerprinted:

An applicant is considered "Unable to be Fingerprinted" for any of the following reasons: Failure to appear for scheduled appointment, inability to present proper identification, inability to present this completed Universal Fingerprint Form IDG_NJAPP_051719_V1, or the information on this form does not exactly match the information provided during the scheduling process. Applicants unable to be fingerprinted will incur a \$12.00 plus tax (\$12.80) appointment fee. Idemia Identity & Security will refund the remainder of the fee paid (state/federal search fees) to the original payment method.

PCN and Receipts:

Upon the completion of fingerprinting you will be assigned a PCN number. The PCN will be recorded on this form and on your receipt. Idemia Identity & Security will not provide duplicate receipts, PCN Numbers or any appointment/printing information after the time of printing.

The New Jersey State Police, State Bureau of Identification (SBI), has entered into a new contract with the existing state vendor Idemia, for fingerprint-based Criminal History Record Information (CHRI) checks. This has resulted in an increase by the vendor in the fees charged for fingerprint-based Criminal History Record Information (CHRI) checks. The effective date of the change is June 1, 2019.

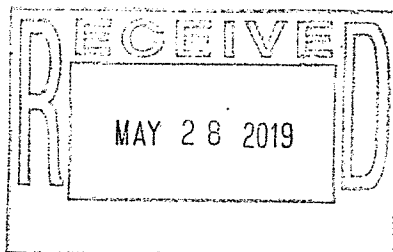
As a participant in the Volunteer Review Operation (VRO) program, SBI has produced new universal fingerprint forms for noncriminal justice applicant fingerprinting by the state vendor, IDEMIA Identity & Security USA LLC. New master copies of the universal forms are enclosed and must be utilized by all applicants effective June 1, 2019. Please destroy your organization's current forms at the close of business on May 31, 2019, and replace them with copies of the enclosed forms reflecting the fee change. We respectfully request that you reproduce these updated forms and keep an ample supply on hand to be distributed to your organization's noncriminal justice applicants.
