 All coaches, assistant coaches, and Team managers must have Level 2 background checks

completed. The law was passed in 2024, but the state keeps pushing back the required by date. Level 1 and Level 2 disqualifications are effectively the same offenses. The difference lies in how deep the check goes, not in what disqualifies someone.
