What is 3v3?

3 v 3 is fun and fast-paced with no goal keepers, no off side, and no slide tackles. Teams may have a maximum of six players, with three on the field and three substitutes. Each team will typically play a minimum of 3 games, (top 2 teams with highest points will play the final). Consisting of two twelve-minute halves separated by a two minute break. Strikers FC will award trophies to the first place and medals to the second place (in each bracket)

Who Can Play?

The soccer event open to players of all skill levels. Youth players must be registered with STYSA, US Club or SAYSOoccer.

How do I determine which age bracket is appropriate for my team?

Teams should be registered in the age-group category of the oldest player on the team, even if players' ages span more than one age group. (See age chart below)

Age Group Birth Year

U-10 January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007

U-9 January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008

U-8 January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009

U-6 January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2011

How do I register for the tournament?

Email the tournament director at maryam.medrano@sfcsooccer.com. *The contact person (person who registers the team) accepts waiver responsibility for their entire team during the registration process.

Necessary Information to complete team registration:

- Players' names
- Players' date of birth
- Players' contact information
- Player card

What if a player is not registered with a soccer club?

All players must be registered with STYSA, US Club Soccer or SAYSOoccer. Any player not registered through either of these organizations, can get a player card through Strikers FC. They must provide a birth certificate or passport and pay a player registration fee of \$20.

Can we change our team name?

Yes - you can email the tournament director, Maryam Arouzi-Medrano at Maryam.medrano@sfc soccer.com to make changes to your roster (including changing your Team Name) **before Friday, April 7, 2017.**

How many players can I have on the roster?

You may carry a maximum of 6 players with a minimum of 3 players. Your team's entry fee is the same regardless of the number of players on the team.

Who needs to attend Check-In?

One member and/or coach from each team must attend the pre-event Check-in to show player cards (non-Strikers FC team/ player) and medical release forms (including all Strikers FC teams/players), and pick up tournament rules.

Can I call the pre-event location to check in my team?

We're sorry, but we can't allow teams to check-in by phone, must be in person.

How do I know my team's registration is complete?

What do I bring to check-in?

You must bring a completed Medical Release Form for all players (Strikers FC players included), proof of Player Registration (Non-Strikers FC players). If your players do not have a player card, a signed letter from your club registrar showing player name, player ID, and birth date will be accepted (birth certificates do not qualify as proof of registration).

How are the divisions formed?

Teams will be placed in divisions based on age and gender. Teams that span more than one age group will be placed in the division of the oldest player on the team.

When will schedules be available?

The Easter Cup schedules will be posted on the Tournament page of the Strikers FC website (visit www.texasrush.com > Events > Easter Cup 3v3 Tournament). Schedules will be available online by April 12, 2017 after 12 noon.

Will standings be updated?

Standings will be updated throughout the day **on-site only.**

What are the rules for the Easter Cup 3v3 Soccer Tournament?

For a complete list of rules and regulations look under Rules on the Tournament page. Please make sure that all players read and understand the rules before the tournament begins.

What are the field dimensions?

U9 and up: 35 by 25 yards. U6 - U8: 30 by 20 yards

Are numbers on jerseys required?

No, but all players must wear similar team shirts (same color) during play. If both teams are wearing the same color, the home team (listed first on the schedule) must change to their alternate shirt/jersey or use pinnies.

Can I request a specific time to play?

Unfortunately, we can't guarantee any accommodation of this type of request.

Are there any player restrictions on casts, or jewelry?

Referees must approve players wearing proactive casts (hard casts will not be allowed). No jewelry will be allowed (including earrings, of any type; rope necklaces and/or bracelets). The only exception will be for players wearing medical bracelets.

Can I change my roster after I am registered?

No, once registration is completed, rosters cannot be updated.

What is the Field Condition telephone number?

To check field conditions, go to our webpages – www.sfcsooccer.com and look under Field Status.

What is the refund policy?

We do not offer full refunds after the registration deadline. If you have questions about this, contact the Tournament Director at maryam.medrano@sfcsooccer.com

What is the refund policy due to weather conditions?

There will be a minimum \$80.00 administration fee for teams that are not able to attend the rescheduled date. *If there are weather challenges, the new date will be May 20, 2017.

Once play has begun there will be no refund.

What is the refund policy if USC schedules my competitive team's game on the tournament date?

We will refund your team the registration fee less a \$80.00 administration fee. (This admin fee covers the web hosting fee, bank charges, and admin costs.) Please notify us within 48 hours of the USC schedule so we can give your place to another team on our wait list.
