President Intentions for 2026

After thoughtful deliberation, I have decided not to seek a 4th term as RTSA President. I have bittersweet emotions regarding this decision as I have been volunteering in RTSA since 2016. I see this as milestone in my life as my sons get older (too fast!) - my son Jack aged out of Travel in June of 2023 (An RTSA alum since the age of 5 who I am proud to say is playing Varsity left or right wing as a junior in Mt. Lakes), and my son Christian will age out of Travel in June of 2026 (An RTSA player since the age of 4 who is starting center mid for his middle school team). Increasing career demands and a shift of family and personal priorities make this move necessary for me. RTSA was founded in 1973. I joined as President in 2023 when the last Board President communicated that if they did not have volunteers to join the Board, the program would have to be handed over to a for-profit club organization. Why there are some advantages to having a Club run a town's program, I feel it was important to have a parent-run soccer program with parents serving as board members and coaches to keep it affordable and to help connect parents with their kids and the community. There are horror stories of clubs taking over town programs to the detriment of the players.

When I was in second grade in Nutley, NJ, my best friend on my street, and I decided that we wanted to play soccer. I talked my father into being our coach. Although my dad had been an athlete when he was younger, he never played soccer. He recruited my older sister's high school boyfriend and his friends from Kearny soccer (those who know, know) to coach us second graders! My dad learned how to coach soccer from them and went on

to coach me for 9 years. When he was dying from cancer in 2010, I sat with him, and we fondly reminisced about all our soccer teams and gigs (I was in his band as a kid) – NOT his job. I still get messages from "kids" he coached 40 years ago saying how he was a positive influence on their lives. I am saying all this to remind everyone that we all can make a similar impact by volunteering, and we need to keep this parent-run program alive for the kids of Rockaway for another 52 years!
