Youth Soccer Tie-Breakers

Four Team tie-breaker rules.

This division will play each other Twice.

Championship Bracket: teams will be seeded according to Record over their 6 games.

If there are ties by two or more teams in the seeded tournament, this is how they will be broken to determine the champion.

- 1.) Head to head
- 2.) Overall season record, determined by points (3 for a win and 1 for a tie)
- 3.) Team with more wins within the tie.
- 4.) Coin Flip to determine the seed number for the bracket.

Tournament Rules:

If the game ends in a tie, captains will be called. You will play two 5 minute, golden goal overtime periods. After the conclusion of the first 5 minute overtime, with no one scoring, you will play a second 5 minute overtime period. Game is over immediately after one team scores during the overtime period.

In the event the game is still tied after two overtime periods, Penalty kicks will determine the winner. Each team will line up their shooters in order from 1 to 11 (these are the players that finished the game). The first 5 will shoot for one team and then the other team will shoot with their 5 shooters. If still tied, then each team will alternate shoots till one team is victorious. If the first shooter makes it and the second missing game is over. If both make it, the second shooters team will shoot first this time.

This goes until there is a winner.
